

## 2025 USATF-NJ COED Club Mini Grand Prix

The LDR Committee has designated a separate series of four Grand Prix Races as **Mini COED Team Championships** in each of the LDR Grand Prix distance Divisions. **Category I: 1-4 miles**. **Category II: >4miles <12k** and **Category III: 12k and above**.

The COED Teams will be in Open/Masters combined teams. Note: <u>This Mini Series is separate from the Club Grand Prix and does not earn team points in the Club Grand Prix.</u>

• February 1, 2025 Penguin Pace 5k

April 6, 2025 Essex County Cherry Blossom 10k

April 27, 2025 Wayne Rotary 5k
 June 26, 2025 Sunset Classic 5 Miler
 August 9, 2025 Three Bridges 5 miler

A. A USATF New Jersey Club may field a single COED Team. Clubs current 2025 USATF-NJ Member Runners 16 or older are eligible to be on a COED team.

To be scored teams must have the indicated number of finishers:

- B. Scoring.
  - 1. COED Team: Declare unlimited men and unlimited women, Score top 3 men and top 3 women. Teams shall be scored using the current plp age graded tables.
- C. Series Scoring: Clubs will earn points based upon plp age grading (not order of finish)
  - 1. First place team: 12 points
  - 2. Second place team: 10 points
  - 3. Third place team: 8 points
  - 4. Fourth place team: 7 points
  - 5. Fifth place team: 6 points
  - 6. Sixth place team: 5 points
  - 7. Seventh place team: 4 points
  - 8. Eighth place team: 3 points
  - 9. Ninth place team: 2 points
  - 10. Tenth place through final place team: 1 point
- D. Placement will add the points earned in each of the races in the COED Team series
- E. Final Standings will be listed for the COED Teams will drop the lowest scoring event or a single event the Club team did not compete in during the year.
- F. Must compete in minimum of four events to be listed in final standings and be eligible for prize money.
- G. Ties are broken by the total number of each teams' Championship wins. If a tie remains it will be broken by the head-to-head plp comparison for all scoring members of the teams in all COED mini Grand Prix Championships in which both teams participated. If still tied, the title will be shared.
- H. MINI COED Series Prize Money. Top five COED Teams will receive prize money:
